Construction Overview

Types and Design

- Ladder trays: Feature two side rails connected by rungs, allowing cables to rest on a single plane with open access for ventilation and maintenance .
- Perforated trays: Have a solid base with holes for airflow and cable tie attachment, but still consist of a single layer .
- Solid-bottom trays: Provide a continuous base for cable support, mainly for protection against dust or small debris, without internal layers .
- Wire mesh (basket) trays: Made of welded steel rods forming a mesh, supporting cables in a single layer while allowing maximum airflow .
- Channel trays: U-shaped or C-shaped trays for small cable runs, also single-layered .
