Fiber Optic Cables and Light Transmission

A fiber optic cable is a thin strand of glass or plastic that transmits data using pulses of light rather than electrical signals. The cable consists of a core, cladding, and protective buffer layers, designed to guide light efficiently over long distances through total internal reflection . Because the data is carried by light, the cable itself is inert and does not consume electricity . This makes fiber optic cables immune to electromagnetic interference, unlike copper cables, and ideal for high-speed data transmission .

Electrical Power in Fiber Networks

While the cable does not require power, the infrastructure and devices that make the fiber network functional do. This includes:

- Optical transmitters and receivers at both ends of the fiber
 - Optical Line Terminals (OLTs) in central offices
 - Data centers and network switches that process and route signals
 - Home devices like Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) that convert light into usable internet data
