This ensures that technicians can make changes without needing to replace the entire cable run.

Design Considerations

- **Splice Trays and Adapters:** ODBs contain splice trays to secure spliced fibers and adapters for connecting incoming and outgoing fibers . These trays often have extra capacity to accommodate additional fiber splices.
- **Slack Management:** The boxes are designed with fiber routing paths and labeled slack storage areas to store excess fiber neatly, preventing bending or damage while keeping it accessible for future use .
- **Capacity Planning:** Many fiber distribution boxes are built with 20–30% headroom beyond the initial fiber count to allow for network expansion without immediate replacement . For example, a box supporting 48 fibers may have space to manage...
