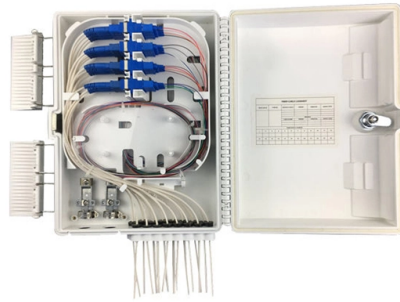

A fiber optic drop cable is the final segment connecting the main network to a subscriber's premises, designed for flexibility, durability, and high-speed signal delivery.

What is a Fiber Optic Drop Cable

A fiber optic drop cable is the last segment of the Optical Distribution Network (ODN), bridging the gap between a distribution terminal (like a Fiber Access Terminal) and the end-user's Optical Network Unit (ONU) or Optical Network Terminal (ONT) . Unlike backbone cables, drop cables typically have 1-4 fibers, are lightweight, flexible, and designed to handle tight bends without signal loss . The quality of the drop cable directly affects attenuation loss and overall network reliability.

Types of Drop Cables

- **Aerial Drop Cables:** Suspended between poles, often with a steel or FRP messenger wire for self-support. Designed to withstand wind, ice, and UV exposure .
- **Underground/Direct-Buried Cables:** Installed in ducts or trenches, sometimes armored or toneable for easy locating. They include water-blocking layers and rodent-resistant jackets .
- **Indoor Drop Cables:** Lightweight, flexible, often with LSZH (Low-Smoke Zero-Halogen) jackets for fire safety. Suitable for routing through walls, conduits, or tight spaces .
