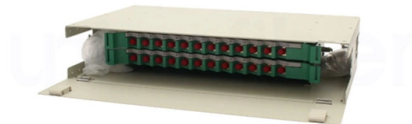


Effective power of the distribution box

The effective power of a distribution box is the maximum electrical load it can safely handle, determined by its rated current, voltage, and protective devices.

Understanding Effective Power

The effective power of a distribution box refers to the total electrical power that can be safely distributed to connected circuits without overloading the system. It depends on the rated current of the box, the voltage of the supply, and the capacity of internal protective devices such as circuit breakers or fuses. Exceeding this power can cause overheating, tripping of breakers, or damage to connected equipment.

Calculating Effective Power

The effective power (in watts) can be estimated using the formula:

- Single-phase system: $P = V \times I$ Where V is the supply voltage (volts) and I is the rated current (amperes).
- Three-phase system: $P = 3 \times V \times I \times \text{Power Factor}$ The power factor accounts for the efficiency of the load, typically between 0.8 and 1 for most installations. For example, a single-phase distribution box rated at 63 A with a 230 V supply can handle approximately: $P = 230 \times 63 \approx 14,490 \text{ W}$ or 14.5 kW.
