

European-style cable tray standard dimensions



Article Overview

European cable trays typically follow IEC 61537 standards, with standard widths from 50mm to 600mm, heights from 25mm to 150mm, and lengths of 2500mm or 3000mm.

Standard Widths

European cable trays are manufactured in nominal inside widths ranging from 50mm to 600mm, with common sizes including 100mm, 200mm, 300mm, and 450mm. The width determines the cable capacity and is critical for proper cable fill and ventilation .

Standard Heights (Depths)

Tray heights, also called side rail heights, generally range from 25mm to 150mm, depending on the volume of cables and ventilation requirements. Taller trays allow for more vertical stacking but may not always improve airflow efficiency; width often provides better cable management .

Standard Lengths

Straight sections of European cable trays are typically produced in lengths of 2500mm or 3000mm, which simplifies transport, installation, and structural design
