

Explanation of Cable Tray Support Distance



Article Overview

Cable tray supports should generally be spaced 4 to 6 feet apart for standard runs, with long or extra-long spans requiring 14 to 20 feet or more depending on tray type and load.

Standard Support Spacing

For most horizontal cable tray installations, the National Electrical Code (NEC) recommends that supports be installed at intervals not exceeding 5 feet, while the ideal spacing is typically 4 to 6 feet to ensure proper load distribution and minimize deflection . Ladder-type trays should have rungs spaced no more than 9 inches apart to support heavy power cables effectively . Perforated and wire mesh trays follow similar spacing rules, with attention to cable weight and ventilation requirements .

Long and Extra-Long Spans

For long-span trays, which are often used in industrial or outdoor applications, supports can be spaced 14 to 20 feet apart, with 20 feet being common . Extra-long spans may exceed 20 feet, sometimes reaching 20 to 40 feet for outdoor crossings or to reduce the number of expensive supports . In these cases, the tray strength and splice plate placement become critical to maintain structural integrity .
