CPUs like Intel Xeon may also be used, but GPUs dominate for parallel computation. **Software Stack:** AI servers run specialized software frameworks for AI workloads, including deep learning libraries, model training tools, and inference engines. This stack ensures efficient utilization of hardware resources and supports large-scale AI applications . **Architecture:** AI servers often operate in clusters, allowing multiple servers to work together as a cohesive system. This setup enables scaling for large AI models, such as large language models (LLMs) or image recognition systems
