GE optical modules support Gigabit Ethernet (1 Gbps) connections, while FE optical modules support Fast Ethernet (100 Mbps) connections, with some modules capable of supporting both types via configurable interfaces.

Overview

GE (Gigabit Ethernet) optical modules are designed for 1 Gbps data transmission and are commonly used in enterprise LANs, data centers, and high-speed network environments. They are typically implemented as SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) transceivers, supporting fiber (SX/LX) or copper (T) connections, and offer features like hot-swappability, backward compatibility with 100 Mbps devices, and digital optical monitoring (DOM) for real-time signal quality assessment . FE (Fast Ethernet) optical modules operate at 100 Mbps and are suitable for less bandwidth-intensive applications, such as legacy networks, industrial Ethernet, or smaller-scale LANs. They are also available as SFP modules and can support multimode or single-mode fiber connections over distances ranging from 2 km to 10 km, depending on the standard (e.g., 100BASE-FX, 100BASE-LX10, 100BASE-BX10), .
