Ladder trays, for example, consist of two side rails connected by rungs, allowing maximum ventilation and easy access to cables . Wire basket trays use a welded steel mesh design with integrated sidewalls to contain large cable bundles .

Installation and Support

These trays are suspended from ceilings, mounted on walls, or supported by racks and cabinets, making them adaptable to various facility layouts . Supports include trapeze hangers, center-span supports, and wall brackets, ensuring stability and proper load distribution . Components like splices, bends, tees, and reducers allow the system to change direction, branch out, or adjust width to accommodate different cable runs .
