Multiple fibers are bundled into loose tube, tight-buffered, or ribbon configurations, then armored or jacketed for indoor, outdoor, aerial, or submarine applications .

- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Optimized for long-distance telecommunications and high-speed data transmission, commonly used in backbone networks .
- Multimode fiber (OM3/OM4/OM5): Cost-effective for short-distance applications like data centers, supporting high-density connections .
- Specialty cables: Include OPGW (Optical Ground Wire), ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting), fire-rated, and sensor cables for industrial or utility applications
