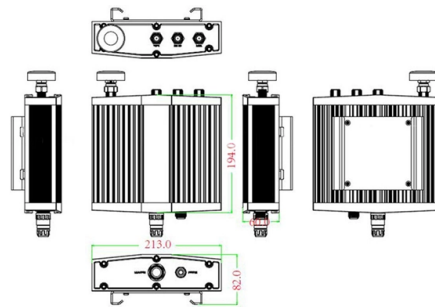


Fiber Optic Cable Project Trial Operation Period

Purpose of the Trial Operation Period

The trial operation period, also known as the commissioning or testing phase, ensures that the fiber optic network meets design specifications and operational requirements. During this period, the system is monitored for:

- Signal integrity and optical performance: Measuring insertion loss, return loss, and attenuation to confirm the network meets expected standards .
- Mechanical and environmental stability: Ensuring cables, connectors, and splices withstand physical stress, temperature variations, and environmental conditions .
- Operational reliability: Detecting potential failures, microbends, or connector issues that could affect long-term performance .

Duration

The duration of the trial operation period varies depending on project complexity, network size, and regulatory requirements. Typically, it ranges from a few days to several weeks, allowing sufficient time to identify and correct issues before the network is officially handed over for full operation
