

Fiber Optic Cable Steel Strap Lifting



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables can be safely lifted using steel straps or synthetic slings with integrated inspection systems to ensure load security and prevent damage.

Lifting Methods and Equipment

Steel wire rope slings are commonly used for lifting heavy fiber optic cables, offering high strength and durability. Cable-laid wire rope slings are more flexible than single-body wire slings, making them suitable for lifting without kinking or damaging the cable, while stainless steel or galvanized finishes improve corrosion resistance in outdoor or industrial environments . Thimbles and sliding choker hooks protect the sling at connection points and allow quick engagement and removal from the load . Synthetic fiber slings such as Slingmax Twin-Path® slings provide an alternative to steel straps. These slings are made from high-performance fibers like K-Spec® and feature redundant load paths, minimal elongation, and abrasion-resistant covers. They are lighter than steel, easier to handle at elevation, and reduce the risk of operator fatigue . Engineered lifting cables from Applied Fiber combine synthetic fibers with hardened steel contact points to prevent damage when pulled over sharp edges or tight bends .

Fiber Optic Inspection and Safety

Some high-performance synthetic slings include fiber optic inspection systems. A fiber optic cable runs through the sling's core, allowing inspectors to check for internal damage by observing light transmission. If the core yarn is damaged due to heat, crushing, or cutting, the fiber optic cable will fail to transmit light, signaling th...
