

Fiber Optic Cable and Pigtail Connection Method

A fiber optic pigtail is spliced to the bare end of a fiber cable, providing a factory-terminated connector for reliable equipment connections.

What is a Fiber Optic Pigtail?

A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The connector end plugs into equipment, patch panels, or Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs), while the bare end is designed to be permanently spliced to an incoming fiber cable. Pigtails are commonly used in single-mode applications and are preferred over patch cords for field terminations because they combine factory precision with flexible field splicing .

Tools and Preparation

Before connecting a pigtail, ensure you have the following tools:

- Fiber stripper to remove the protective coating from the fiber
- Fiber cleaver for precise cutting of the fiber end
- Fusion splicer or mechanical splicing kit
- Isopropyl alcohol wipes for cleaning
- Protective splice tray to secure the joint Proper cleaning and preparation are critical, as dust or misalignment can cause high signal loss
