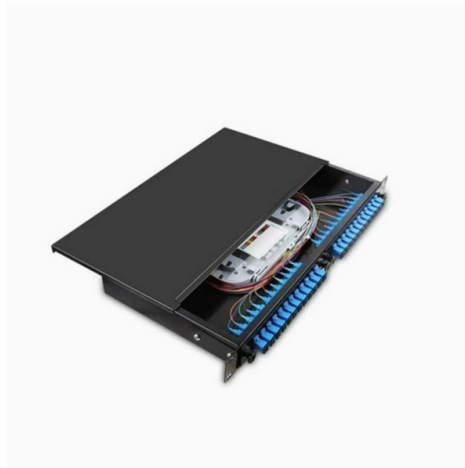

- Cost-effective and widely used for smaller applications (e.g., 1×2, 1×4 configurations).
- Suitable for passive networks where lower split ratios are needed .
