 - Limited splitter support; best for small-scale deployments .
- FDB (Fiber Distribution Box)
 - Designed for structured fiber routing, often used in MDU buildings.
 - Supports organized splitter placement and multiple floors.
 - Typically indoor or semi-protected; not ideal for harsh outdoor conditions .
- CTO (Centralized Termination/Optical Terminal) Boxes
 - Hardened outdoor closures for pre-connectorized FTTH deployment.
 - High waterproof ratings (IP65-IP68), UV-stable materials, and plug-and-play installation.
 - Can be splice-based or pre-terminated, suitable for poles, façades, or outdoor cabinets .
