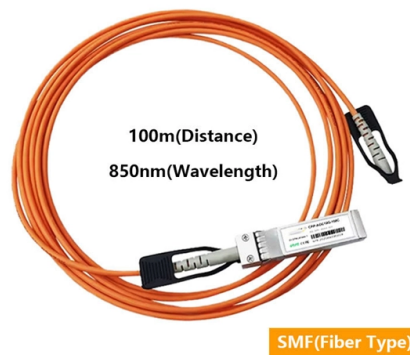


Fiber optic base station patch cord connection method



Article Overview

Proper connection of fiber optic patch cords in base stations requires careful cleaning, alignment, bend-radius management, and testing to ensure low insertion loss and reliable signal transmission.

Selecting the Right Patch Cord

Choose a patch cord that matches the fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and connector type (LC, SC, APC, UPC) compatible with your base station equipment. Ensure the cord length is sufficient to reach devices without excessive slack, and select bend-insensitive fibers for tight routing spaces .

Preparation and Cleaning

Before connecting, clean all connectors using a lint-free pad with isopropyl alcohol or a dedicated fiber cleaning kit. Inspect the end face under a microscope to remove dust, dirt, or scratches, as even particles smaller than 20 microns can degrade signal quality by 20–30% . Never cross-mate SC/APC with SC/UPC connectors due to incompatible endface geometry .

Connection Procedure

- Align the connector carefully with the mating interface on the base station or patch panel.
- Insert fully until it clicks or seats properly, ensuring no lateral stress is applied....
