

Fiber optic broadband connection to router

Fiber optic broadband connects to your router via an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts light signals into Ethernet-compatible data.

Required Equipment

To set up a fiber connection, you will need:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, it converts optical signals to electrical signals for your router .
- Fiber optic cable: Typically a thin, yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet cable: To link the ONT to your router .
- Compatible router: Ensure it has a WAN port or SFP port for Ethernet input .

Step-by-Step Connection

- Install the ONT:
 - Locate the fiber entry point in your home.
 - Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port, handling the cable carefully to avoid dirt or damage .
 - Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to your ISP .
- Connect the ONT to the Router:
 - Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WA...
