Fiber optic cable connectors are precise mechanical devices that join optical fibers, enabling fast, low-loss connections for high-speed data transmission.

Overview

Fiber optic connectors are used to align and join optical fibers where a connect/disconnect capability is required, allowing light signals to pass through with minimal loss. Unlike permanent splicing, connectors provide flexibility for maintenance, upgrades, and network reconfiguration. They consist of several key components: a ferrule to hold and align the fiber, a connector body for protection, an attachment mechanism for secure mating, and boots for strain relief and durability .

Common Connector Types

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Square-shaped with a push-pull coupling mechanism, widely used in FTTH deployments and data centers. SC/APC variants offer low return loss for RF video and GPON networks .
- LC (Lucent Connector): Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications. Uses a latch mechanism similar to RJ45 plugs .
- ST (Straight Tip): Round connector with a bayonet-style twist lock, commonly used in legacy networks and industrial applications .
- FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-on type, providing high stability and low signal loss, often used in single-mode fiber applications .
- MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On): High-density connectors for multi-fiber arrays, suitable for data centers and backbone networks .
- MU (Miniature Unit): Compact connector for high-density applications, often used i...
