Article Overview

Metallic components of fiber optic systems, including guy wires, must be properly grounded to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, and lightning hazards.

Key Principles

Fiber optic cables themselves transmit light and do not carry electrical current, so the fiber core does not require grounding. However, many fiber optic cables include metallic elements such as steel armoring, copper strength members, aluminum moisture barriers, or metallic messenger wires, all of which must be grounded according to electrical codes and industry standards (NEC Article 770, NFPA 70, ANSI/TIA/EIA-J-STD-607) to ensure safety and system integrity .

Grounding Requirements for Guy Wires

- Exposed guys (supporting fiber optic cables) that are metallic must be grounded if they are subject to power contacts, induction, or lightning. This includes guys attached to poles with supply conductors, crossing supply conductors, or within 8 feet horizontally of supply conductors .
- Grounding conductors connecting the guy wire to the ground electrode must be continuous and mechanically robust, typically minimum No. 6 AWG copper, and buried at least 1 foot below the surface .
- Connection points should be at the base of the pole or at a designated grounding electrode, ensuring a short, direct path to maintain continuity and minimize resistance .
- Compression or mechanical connectors must be suitable for outdoor exposure an...
