

Fiber optic cable is not powered

If your fiber optic cable has no power, start by checking the power supply to your Optical Network Terminal (ONT) and inspect all cables and connectors for damage or contamination.

Step 1: Check Power and Equipment

Ensure that the ONT, media converters, or switches connected to the fiber network are powered on and receiving electricity. Look for indicator lights; a “LOS” (Loss of Signal) LED often signals connectivity issues due to power or signal loss . If devices are unresponsive, try power cycling by unplugging and reconnecting them to reset temporary faults .

Step 2: Inspect Fiber Cables

Visually examine the fiber optic cables for cuts, sharp bends, kinks, or loose connections. Even minor physical damage can prevent signal transmission . Ensure that cables are routed properly and not exceeding their minimum bend radius, as excessive bending can cause light leakage and signal attenuation .

Step 3: Clean Connectors

Dirty connectors are a common cause of fiber outages. Use a fiber inspection microscope to check for dust, oil, or debris on the ferrules. Clean connectors with lint-free wipes, isopropyl alcohol, or specialty fiber cleaning tools, following an inspect → clean → inspect → mate workflow .
