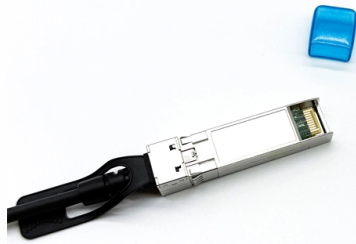


Fiber optic cable is too dirty

Dirty fiber optic cables can severely disrupt signal transmission, so proper cleaning and inspection are essential for reliable network performance.

Why Fiber Gets Dirty

Fiber optic connectors are extremely sensitive to contamination. Even microscopic dust particles, oils from fingerprints, moisture, or residue from cleaning solutions can block or scatter light, causing signal loss, poor data transmission, or total failure .

Common sources of contamination include:

- Dust particles settling from the air or clothing
 - Skin oils from handling connectors
 - Moisture or condensation forming thin films on the ferrule surface
 - Residue from improper cleaning or solvents
 - Cross-contamination when a dirty connector mates with a clean one
- Dirty connectors are a leading cause of network problems, responsible for 15-50% of connection issues .

Tools for Cleaning

Proper cleaning requires specialized tools to avoid damage:

- Lint-free cleaning wipes for delicate surfaces
- Fiber cleaning pens or sticks (click-clean or CLETOP-S) for end-face cleaning
- Cleaning cassettes for male and female connectors...
