

Fiber optic cable not working after adding coupler

A fiber optic cable may stop working after adding a coupler due to connector misalignment, contamination, or signal loss introduced by the coupler.

Common Causes

Connector Contamination: Dust, oil, or debris on the fiber end-faces or inside the coupler can block light transmission, causing signal loss or complete failure. Even small particles can significantly degrade performance . **Misalignment:** Fiber couplers require precise alignment. If the connectors are not seated correctly or the coupler is incompatible with the fiber type (single-mode vs multimode), the signal may not pass through . **Excessive Insertion Loss:** Every coupler introduces some signal attenuation. If the coupler's loss exceeds the system's tolerance, the link may fail, especially in long-distance or high-speed networks . **Physical Damage:** Bends, kinks, or stress on the fiber near the coupler can cause light leakage or breakage, leading to intermittent or no connectivity .

Troubleshooting Steps

- **Inspect and Clean Connectors:** Use a fiber microscope or approved lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to clean the fiber end-faces and coupler ports. Follow an inspect → clean → inspect → mate workflow .
- **Check Alignment and Seating:** Ensure the fiber connectors are fully inserted and properly aligned in the coupler. Verify that the coupler type matches the fiber type.
- **Test Signal Strength:** Use an optical power meter or visual fault locator to measur...
