Connector Compatibility

Most modern SFP modules use LC connectors, while older modules may use SC, and high-density systems may use MPO/MTP connectors . To connect a patch cord to a module:

- The connector type of the patch cord must match the module's port (e.g., LC-to-LC for standard SFPs).
- Mismatched connectors require adapters, which can introduce insertion loss and reduce signal quality .
- Duplex patch cords are typically used for modules requiring separate transmit and receive fibers....
