A Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) Information Distribution Box is a secure enclosure that terminates, protects, and distributes optical fibers from the provider's network to individual homes or premises.

Overview and Function

A fiber distribution box (FDB), also called a fiber termination box or network access point (NAP), is a passive device that serves as the critical junction between the backbone feeder cable and the last-mile drop cables reaching subscribers . It provides mechanical protection, environmental sealing, and organized fiber management, ensuring reliable signal distribution in FTTH networks . Essentially, it acts like a sorting facility for optical signals, directing the main fiber network to individual homes or offices .

Key Components

- Splice Trays: Securely hold fusion or mechanical splices of optical fibers.
- Adapters and Panels: Facilitate connections between incoming feeder fibers and outgoing drop fibers.
- Fiber Routing Guides: Maintain minimum bend radius and prevent fiber damage.
- PLC Splitters (optional): Divide a single fiber's bandwidth among multiple subscribers in PON networks .
- Labeling and Slack Management: Clearly identifies each fiber and stores excess cable for maintenance or future expansion
