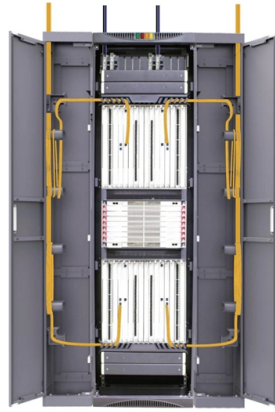


Fire cable tray GB standard



Article Overview

Fire-resistant cable trays are designed to maintain circuit integrity during fire, and while China's GB standards exist for fire safety, DIN 4102-12 and E90 ratings are commonly referenced internationally for testing and compliance.

Fire Resistance and Ratings

Fire-resistant cable trays are engineered to support cables during fire events, ensuring that circuits remain operational for critical systems. Internationally, the DIN 4102-12 standard is widely used to test cable trays, requiring the system to withstand temperatures up to 1000°C for 30, 60, and 90 minutes, with some products tested up to 120 minutes achieving an E90 rating. These tests simulate real fire conditions and assess the tray's ability to maintain structural integrity and support cables without collapse. In China, GB standards such as GB 50016 (Code for Fire Protection Design of Buildings) and GB 50217 (Code for Design of Electrical Installations in Buildings) provide fire safety requirements for cable systems, including fire-resistant cables and containment. While a dedicated GB standard for cable tray fire resistance may not be explicitly defined, compliance is typically achieved by using fire-rated cables (e.g., FP600) and fireproof trays that meet equivalent international test criteria.
