

Five switches interconnected via fiber optic cables



Article Overview

Five switches can be interconnected using fiber optics in either a star or ring topology, with redundancy achieved through dual links or EtherChannel configurations.

Topology Options

Star Topology: In a star configuration, all five switches connect to a central core switch. This setup simplifies management and reduces the risk of network loops. Each switch has a dedicated fiber link to the core, ensuring high performance and minimal collisions. Fiber optics allow high bandwidth and long-distance connections without signal degradation, making this ideal for enterprise networks with multiple switches ().

Ring Topology: A ring topology connects each switch to two neighboring switches, forming a closed loop. This provides redundancy because data can travel in both directions; if one link fails, traffic is rerouted the opposite way. Ring topologies are common in industrial or high-availability networks but require ring protection protocols to prevent broadcast storms ().

Hybrid Approach: For five switches, a hybrid design can combine a core star with a secondary ring among edge switches. This allows centralized control while maintaining redundancy and scalability ().

Redundancy and Link Aggregation

To enhance reliability, consider dual fiber links between switches and configure EtherChannel (port aggregation) on Cisco or compatible switches. This provides bot...
