

Fixing distance of cable tray wall supports



Overview

Mark the support, fix the threaded rod supports with appropriate metal plugs, and then fix the 'L' angles / Slotted 'C' channels with nuts. 2 M distance is maintained between the supports to avoid the sagging of trays and ladders. A cable support system consists of cable support lengths and system components, such as cable support fittings, support elements, mounting elements and system accessories. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (A)) in that document provides requirements for cable support. When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0.
