Materials and Construction

- E30, E60, E90: Indicating the tray can maintain electrical functionality for 30, 60, or 90 minutes .
- DIN 4102-12: A German standard requiring the entire cable tray system to be tested in an oven at temperatures up to 1000°C for 30, 60, and 90 minutes .
- FP400 and FP600 compliance: For low and high voltage cables, ensuring compatibility with fire-resistant cable types
