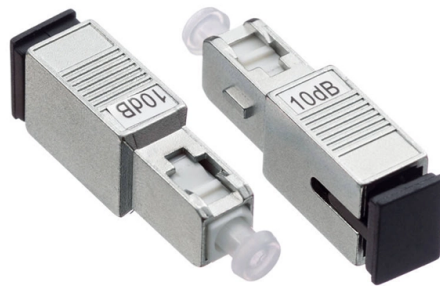


Four sections of low-voltage busbars
