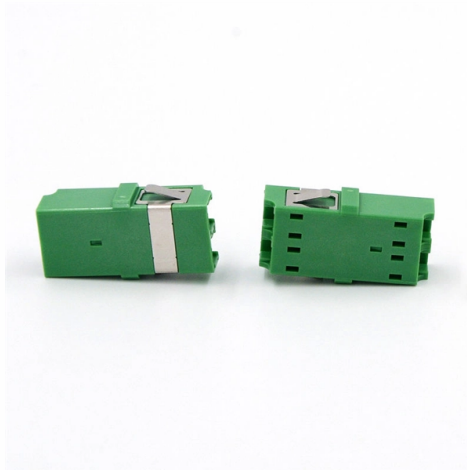

- **Coatings:** Dual-layer UV-cured acrylate coatings protect the fiber from mechanical damage while maintaining optical performance (Zion Communication) .
- **Buffer Tubes and Sheathing:** Protective layers, including polyethylene (PE), low-smoke zero-halogen (LSZH), or flame-retardant jackets, provide mechanical strength, moisture resistance, and environmental protection (Corning)
