Splicing and Splitting: Optical terminal boxes support fiber splicing and the integration of splitters, enabling efficient distribution of signals in Passive Optical Networks (PONs) such as GPON, XGS-PON, or 25G PON. This ensures reliable high-speed connectivity to end-users .
