Purpose of Grounding

Grounding a distribution box switch is essential to:

- Protect personnel from electric shocks during normal and fault conditions.

- Provide a low-resistance path for fault currents, ensuring protective devices like fuses or circuit breakers operate correctly .

Grounding Methods

- **Connection to Grounding Bus (PE Bus):** The distribution box should have a dedicated grounding bus connected directly to the facility's main grounding system. All components requiring grounding, including the switch, must be connected to this bus using copper wires or braided conductors .
- **Metal Enclosure Grounding:** The metal casing of the distribution box must be grounded using a box grounding bolt marked with PE. This ensures the enclosure itself is safe to touch and any fault current is directed to ground .
- **Pipe and Conduit Bonding:** Any metal conduit or threaded pipe connected to the box should be electrically bonded to the box to maintain continuity and prevent potential differences that could cause shocks .
- **External Grounding Connection:** A ground wire should run from the mounting plat...
