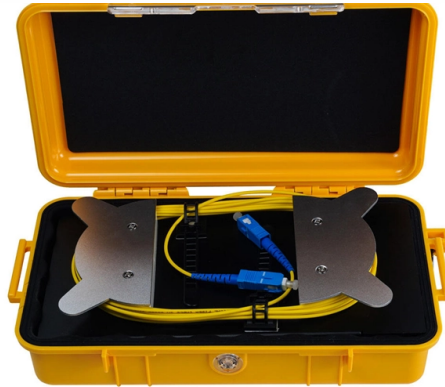


Height of the on-site three-level distribution box from the ground



Overview

Wall-mounted boxes should be 4. This height makes it easy to reach without bending or stretching. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid. The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. Covers wiring, placement, standards, and expert tips for a compliant setup. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1. Site selection requirements: The distribution box should be installed in an area close to the power supply to reduce. Distribution boxes shall be made of non-combustible materials; open distribution boards may be installed in production places and offices with low electric shock risk; enclosed cabinets shall be installed in processing workshops, foundries, forging, heat treatment, boiler rooms, woodworking houses. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board.
