A PoE switch can power compatible devices and simplify cabling, while a regular switch is cheaper and sufficient if you don't need to power devices over Ethernet.

Key Differences

- **Power Delivery:** A PoE switch provides both data and electrical power over a single Ethernet cable, ideal for devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, and wireless access points. A regular switch only transmits data, so each device needs its own power source .
- **Cost:** Regular switches are generally more affordable, especially for basic home setups. PoE switches are more expensive due to the additional power circuitry .
- **Installation Flexibility:** PoE switches allow devices to be installed in locations without nearby power outlets, reducing cable clutter and simplifying deployment .
- **Device Compatibility:** PoE switches can function as regular switches for non-PoE devices, often by disabling the PoE function. Regular switches cannot provide power to PoE devices unless a separate PoE injector is used .

- You want simpler cabling and centralized power management.
