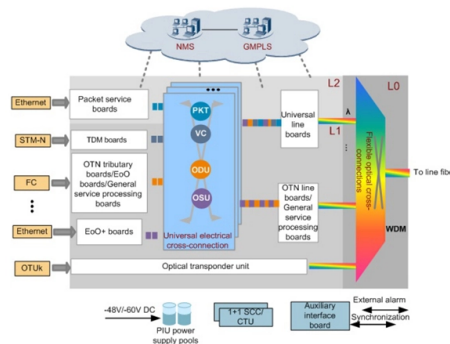


How are network rack patch cords made
