DTU Communication Overview

The Distribution Terminal Unit (DTU) acts as the "nerve endings" of the distribution network, collecting data from switches, feeders, and other devices, and transmitting it to the dispatching system for centralized control and monitoring. It integrates multiple intelligent devices and supports real-time telemetry, remote control, and fault detection.

 - Ethernet ports: 10/100M for high-speed data transmission
 - Optional wireless interfaces for remote or hard-to-reach locations
