

How far do optical fiber cables span

Single-mode fiber can span thousands of kilometers with amplification, while multimode fiber is typically limited to a few hundred meters to a few kilometers.

Fiber Types and Distance Limits

Multimode Fiber (MMF):

- Designed for short-range applications such as data centers, campus networks, and intra-building links.
 - Core diameter is typically 50–62.5 μm , allowing multiple light modes to propagate, which causes modal dispersion and limits distance.
 - Practical distances range from 300 meters to 2 kilometers, depending on fiber grade (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4) and data rate .
 - Higher-speed networks (10–100 Gbps) reduce the effective distance due to increased dispersion and attenuation .
- Single-mode Fiber (SMF):
- Core diameter is 8–10 μm , allowing only a single light path, minimizing dispersion.
 - Ideal for long-haul telecommunications, metropolitan area networks, and submarine cables.
 - Standard unamplified distances range from 40 km to over 100 km for typical deployments .
 - With optical amplifiers (e.g., Erbium-doped fiber amplifiers, EDFAs) or regenerators, distances can extend to thousands of kilometers, as seen in submarine cables spanning 10,000+ km .
 - Ultra-long terrestrial links have achieved over 10,000 km on a single fiber with amplification
