Typical Replacement Duration

While small-scale replacements in a controlled environment may be completed in a day, larger installations or backbone upgrades can span several days to weeks, depending on cable length, network complexity, and accessibility.

- **Installation Environment:** Underground ducts, aerial lines, or industrial settings can complicate access and handling.
- **Damage Severity:** Physical damage, such as crushed or severed cables, requires more preparation and careful splicing
