

How long is the fiber optic cable in the junction box

The fiber optic cable inside a junction box typically includes 1-2 meters of slack, but the exact length depends on installation requirements and routing.

Typical Cable Length and Slack

Fiber optic junction boxes, also called termination or distribution boxes, are designed to manage and protect fiber connections while providing enough slack for splicing and routing to devices like ONTs (Optical Network Terminals) or routers. The internal cable from the external feeder to the ONT usually comes in various lengths, often ranging from 2 to 8 meters in residential installations, depending on the distance between the entry point and the device location. Installers generally provide extra slack to accommodate routing around corners, skirting boards, or minor relocations.

Installation Considerations

- **Bend Radius:** Fiber cables cannot be bent sharply. The minimum bend radius is typically around 30 mm (roughly the diameter of a £2 coin) to prevent damage and signal loss.
- **Routing:** Slack is stored in splice trays or fiber loops inside the junction box to allow for future maintenance or reconfiguration.
- **Connection to Devices:** The fiber from the junction box connects to the ONT, which then links to the router via Ethernet. The ONT itself usually has a short power lead (~1 meter), so the fiber cable must reach the ONT location without sharp bends
