

How many circuits are possible in a lighting distribution box

A lighting distribution box typically contains multiple circuits, with the exact number depending on load requirements, panel size, and regulatory standards, commonly ranging from 6 to 24 ways in residential units, and up to 42 or more in commercial panels.

Typical Configuration

A distribution box, also called a consumer unit or panelboard, divides incoming electrical power into multiple circuits, each protected by its own MCB (Miniature Circuit Breaker) or RCBO (Residual Current Breaker with Overload) . For lighting circuits specifically, the number of circuits depends on the total lighting load and the amperage of each branch circuit. In residential installations, a standard new domestic consumer unit may have 6 to 24 ways, with some circuits occupying two ways .

Determining the Number of Lighting Circuits

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC 2026), the minimum lighting load for a dwelling is 2 VA per square foot, and a typical 15-Amp lighting branch circuit can serve approximately 600 ft² . For example, a 3,000 ft² home would require at least 5 lighting circuits ($3,000 \div 600 = 5$). Larger commercial or industrial panels may accommodate up to 42 overcurrent devices for lighting and appliance circuits, following the previous NEC 42-circuit rule, though modern panels can exceed this limit ...
