

How many circuits can a distribution box connect at most

A distribution box can typically hold between 2 and 42 circuits, depending on its design, size, and the type of breakers used.

Standard Panel Capacity

The maximum number of circuits a distribution box (or electrical panel) can hold is primarily determined by its physical design and manufacturer specifications. Standard residential panels often have 30 to 42 slots for circuit breakers, with each slot accommodating a single-pole breaker for a 120V circuit or half of a double-pole breaker for a 240V circuit. Double-pole breakers occupy two adjacent slots, reducing the total number of circuits that can be installed.

Use of Tandem or Slimline Breakers

To increase the number of circuits beyond the standard slot count, some panels allow tandem (duplex) breakers, which fit two independent circuits into a single slot. For example, a 30-slot panel may support up to 45 circuits if tandem breakers are permitted in designated slots. It is important to follow the panel's labeling and UL listing, as not all panels are rated for tandem breakers. Installing more breakers than the panel's rated capacity can cause overheating or electrical hazards.
