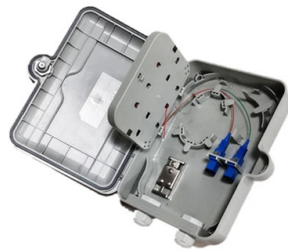


How many fiber optic cables need to be connected to one room

Although the maximum distance of fiber optic cable is affected by both attenuation and dispersion, for most applications, the maximum distance of any type of fiber optic cable is around 62.14 miles (100 kilometers). However, some applications require longer distances. For these applications, fiber optic cables with special dispersion-compensating fibers are used.
