

How many meters is a long-span cable tray

Long-span cable trays typically span 6 meters (20 feet) or more between supports, with some systems reaching up to 12 meters (40 feet) in length.

Typical Lengths and Support Spacing

Long-span cable trays are designed to cover large distances between supports without compromising structural stability, making them ideal for high-bay warehouses, stadiums, bridges, and industrial facilities . Standard long-span trays usually support intervals of 6 meters (approximately 20 feet) or more, while some extra-long spans can reach 12 meters (40 feet), particularly in outdoor or industrial applications . For comparison, standard cable trays are often supported every 3 to 4 meters (10–12 feet), whereas long-span trays reduce the number of supports required, which can lower installation costs and simplify routing . Manufacturers may offer customizable lengths such as 3m, 6m, 8m, 12m, or even longer, depending on project requirements .

Structural Considerations

Long-span trays often feature reinforced side plates or prestressed designs to handle heavy cable loads and minimize deflection over extended spans . The tray material, rung spacing, and side rail height are critical factors in determining the maximum safe span. For aluminum long-span trays, straight sections of 12.2 meters (40 feet) are common, requiring support only at the ends
