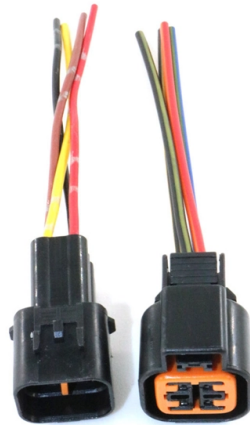


How many square millimeters of wiring should be used for the distribution box

Wiring in a distribution box typically ranges from 1.5 mm² to 10 mm² for standard circuits, depending on the load and application.

Common Wire Sizes

In most residential and commercial distribution boxes, the following cross-sectional areas (mm²) are commonly used:

- 1.5 mm²: Used for lighting circuits and low-power devices, typically rated for 10–16 A .
- 2.5 mm²: Standard for general-purpose outlets and small appliances, rated for 16–20 A .
- 4 mm²: Often used for higher-power appliances like water heaters or small air conditioners, rated for 25–32 A .
- 6 mm²: Suitable for larger appliances or sub-circuits, rated for 32–40 A .
- 10 mm² and above: Used for main incoming supply lines or heavy-duty equipment, rated for 40–63 A or more . These sizes are standardized according to IEC 60228, which defines nominal conductor areas for insulated cables, ensuring consistent current-carrying capacity and safety . The choice of wire size depends on the current load, voltage drop, cable length, and installation conditions such as ambient temperature and insulation type .
