

How much does it cost to install a 1-to-8 optical splitter

Splitter Hardware Costs

- Cassette-style splitters for home or office wiring are typically in the \$60-\$150 range, depending on quality and connector type .

Installation Costs

Installation costs depend on the environment and labor requirements:

- Simple indoor installation (splicing or connecting to existing fiber) can range from \$100-\$200, including labor and minor materials.
- Complex installations (outdoor cabinets, long fiber runs, or integration into a PON network) may cost \$200-\$300 or more, especially if splicing, testing, and labeling a...
