

How should the fiber optic cable be connected to the switch

To connect a fiber optic cable to a switch, you need compatible SFP/SFP+ transceiver modules, the correct fiber type, and proper connectors, ensuring the switch supports fiber ports or using a media converter if it does not.

Step 1: Identify Switch Ports

Check your switch to determine the type of fiber optic ports available, such as SFP, SFP+, XFP, or QSFP+. This information is usually in the switch documentation or labeled on the device itself. Some switches have combo ports, which share a copper RJ45 port and a fiber port, but only one can be active at a time .

Step 2: Select the Appropriate Transceiver Module

Choose a transceiver module compatible with both your switch port and the fiber optic cable type:

- SFP modules: Typically support up to 1 Gbps.
- SFP+ modules: Support up to 10 Gbps.
- Single-mode modules: For long-distance connections (kilometers), usually 1310nm or 1550nm wavelength.
- Multi-mode modules: For short-distance connections (hundreds of meters), usually 850nm wavelength
