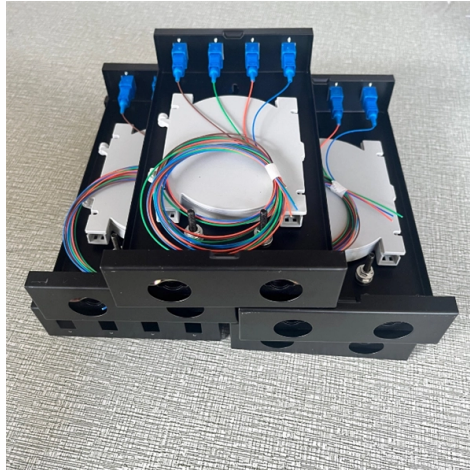


How to configure an optical interface switch



Article Overview

Optical interfaces on switches are configured by selecting the appropriate transceiver, setting interface attributes, and optionally using interface split or aggregation for flexible connectivity.

Initial Setup

Before configuring optical interfaces, ensure the switch is properly installed, powered, and connected to a console or management interface for CLI access. Use a console cable and terminal emulation software (VT100) to access the switch CLI and configure basic network settings such as IP address and SNMP parameters if needed .

Selecting and Installing Optical Modules

Choose the correct optical module type based on the interface speed and distance requirements:

- QSFP-DD 400G Digital Coherent Optics: Supports long-haul transmission with ZR or ZR+ variants, configurable for modulation, FEC mode, Tx power, and wavelength .
- 10GE/40GE Modules: Can be used directly or in split configurations for multiple lower-speed connections . Ensure the module wavelength matches the remote device if connecting to split interfaces.
