

How to configure bridging on a fiber optic switch



Article Overview

Bridging a fiber optic connection to a switch typically involves using a fiber media converter or configuring the ONT/ONU in bridge mode to connect fiber networks to Ethernet switches while maintaining proper VLAN and network settings.

Using Fiber Media Converters

Fiber media converters allow you to connect fiber-optic cables to Ethernet switches, converting optical signals to electrical signals and vice versa. To set up a bridging configuration:

- Select the appropriate converter: Ensure the converter supports your fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and the desired speed (10/100/1000 Mbps) ().
- Connect fiber cables: Plug the fiber cable into the TX (transmit) and RX (receive) ports of the converter. Handle fiber carefully to avoid damage ().
- Connect Ethernet to switch: Use an RJ45 Ethernet cable to connect the converter to your switch port. This bridges the fiber network to your copper-based devices ().
- Power and configure: Power the converter. Basic models work automatically, but advanced converters may allow configuration of duplex mode, wavelength, or speed via DIP switches or a web interface ().
- Test connectivity: Verify link and activity LEDs to ensure proper bridging. Check that devices on both sides of the fiber link can communicate ().
