

How to connect a fiber optic cold splice to a pigtail



Article Overview

To connect a fiber optic cold splice to a pigtail, you prepare the fibers, align them precisely, perform a fusion or mechanical splice, and protect the joint to ensure low-loss transmission.

Step 1: Gather Tools and Materials

Before starting, ensure you have the following:

- Fiber optic pigtail with a factory-terminated connector on one end
- Fusion splicer or mechanical splice kit
- Fiber stripper and cleaver
- Isopropyl alcohol wipes and lint-free cloths
- Heat-shrink splice protector or sleeve
- OTDR or power meter for testing

Step 2: Prepare the Fibers

- Strip the outer jacket of both the incoming fiber and the pigtail to expose the bare glass fiber.
- Clean the fibers with alcohol wipes to remove dust, oils, and debris.
- Cleave the fibers using a precision cleaver to create a flat, perpendicular end-face. Proper cleaving is critical for low-loss splicing .
